Unaccompanied homeless youth are young people who lack safe, stable housing not in the care of a parent or guardian. They may have run away from home, forced to leave by their parents and live in a variety of temporary situations, including shelters, the homes of friends, relatives, cars, campgrounds, parks, abandoned buildings, motels, bus or train stations. The Office of Financial Aid at Mercer County Community College is required to request and review documentation to support your status. Failure to submit any requested documentation will result in you being ineligible for Federal student aid.
