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Measuring Intelligence

- IQ Test (intelligence quotient)
 - Alfred Binet
- What do IQ Scores Predict?
 - IQ and school success are highly correlated
 - Self-discipline
 - 55-70 Educable /40-55 Trainable / 39-40 Severe to Profound
- Hereditary and Environmental Factors
